

MEXICAN AMERICAN BAR FOUNDATION ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2023

The Mexican American Bar Foundation proudly announces the opening of the application season for its annual scholarship awards program. Since 1991, the Foundation has pursued its mission of promoting diversity in the legal profession through education by awarding scholarships to Latino law students.

CRITERIA

In awarding scholarships, the Foundation's Scholarship Committee considers the applicant's financial need, academic achievement, community service, leadership experience and any hardship experienced in pursuing an education. Scholarship amounts will depend on fundraising efforts with the goal of awarding scholarships up to \$15,000.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility is limited to matriculated law students who: (1) are of Hispanic/Latino heritage or descent; (2) currently attend ABA-accredited law schools in Los Angeles County (Loyola, Pepperdine, Southwestern, UCLA, and USC), or UC Irvine School of Law in Orange County; and (3) will be enrolled during the 2023-24 academic year. You are required to inform the Scholarship Committee if you intend to or have applied to transfer to a school that is not included above. We regret we do not have the resources to assist other students.

Answer all questions. The quality and accuracy of your application are critical. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
